

Waste separation and how to dispose of the waste, and waste collection schedule

This program and schedule only apply to waste generated by ordinary households and residents of Moriguchi City. (Waste generators must dispose of waste generated from their industrial activities on their own.) You can dispose of up to **two bags** of refuse per collection by category (excluding bulky waste). **Waste that is not correctly separated will not be collected.**

Important points when disposing of waste	<p>Note: For unrecyclable used paper/cloth that is dirty, dispose of it with a label displaying the fact.</p> <p>Note: Soak cigarettes, cigarette lighters, and other flammable objects into water before putting them into the garbage to prevent ignition.</p>	<p>Note: Dispose of items that come with products (straws with beverage cartons, spoons with lunch boxes, etc.) as burnable waste.</p> <p>Note: Do not mix plastic products, such as buckets and toys, with containers and packaging waste.</p>	<p>Note: Dispose of vinyl coated paper and carbon paper as burnable waste.</p> <p>Note: Dispose of used paper/cloth on days when it is collected by neighborhood associations and other entities in your residential area if possible.</p>	<p>Note: Be sure to put used cloth and clothing into a trash bag.</p> <p>Note: Futon and zabuton, or Japanese cushions, are classified as miscellaneous trash.</p>	<p>Note: Empty spray cans and portable gas cartridges and put them in a separate bag with a label displaying the word "DANGER." How to make an appointment for the collection of bulky waste

Payment and prior appointment required

- Make an appointment at least two days (except for Saturdays and Sundays) before regular oversized waste collection days (twice a month).

How to make an appointment for the collection of large volumes of trash

Payment and prior appointment required

- Make an appointment at least one day (morning) before your desired appointment date. Use this collection service when you need to dispose of a large quantity of waste at a time, such as when moving and cleaning up. (The collection fee is 8,000 yen per truck. For waste on more than one truck, 4,000 yen is charged for each extra truck.)
- *The waste collector will give you a statement of payment. Pay the fee at a financial institution later.

How to make an appointment regarding dead animals

Payment and contact required

- In the case of dogs or cats whose ownership is not known, there is no fee.
- Call the Telephone Appointment Center if you want to request the city to collect a dead animal or you wish to carry it to a municipal facility.
- You can bring a dead animal to Moriguchi City Hall or the incineration facilities (Clean Center).
- *When a collector picks the animal up, the collector issues a statement of payment. Pay the fee at a financial institution later.
- *After hours on weekdays and on Saturdays and Sundays, the staff in the gatehouse of the Moriguchi City Hall will keep the dead animal.
- *When you wish to bury or hold a memorial service for a dead animal, ask private pet cemeteries, etc. about it.

Carrying in waste

Payment and prior appointment required

- Make an appointment at least one day (except for Saturdays and Sundays) before your desired appointment date.
- You can bring in waste from Monday to Friday (including national holidays).
- [Place where you can bring your waste] Moriguchi City Clean Center (Incineration facilities)
- [Burnable waste] 90 yen per 10 kg (pay in cash)
- [Bulky waste] Attach a bulky waste collection fee ticket worth 300-1,800 yen to each item.
- Bringing in recyclables is free of charge.
- *Attach bulky waste collection fee tickets to your bulky waste in advance before carrying in it.
