Collection at the city's designated facilities

Bringing small appliances to drop-off boxes

The city has nine drop-off boxes at the city hall and associated facilities to collect used small appliances, such as cameras and game consoles, that can be thrown in the boxes through their slots (20 x 35 cm).

For details such as items that can be collected, check them on the city's website.

Courier collection from your home



There is **no fee** if a PC is included.

- OK even if the PC is old.
- OK even if the PC is broken.
- OK even if the PC is home-built.
- OK even if the PC doesn't have a hard disk.

1,500 yen per box (excluding tax)

Moriguchi City has signed an agreement with ReNet Japan Recycle, Inc., a nationally certified collection service provider, to collect small appliances, including PCs, from your home via a courier service. You can use this service **free of charge** if a PC is included.

The total dimensions (width, depth, and height) of a box for delivery must be 140 cm or shorter. If the weight of the box is 20 kg or lighter, you can put as many items as possible in it.

*Be sure to delete data stored on your computer.

*An extra fee is charged for a CRT monitor because it costs money to dispose of it.

*A separate fee is charged for more than one box.

How to distinguish between oversized waste and miscellaneous trash

The waste item is listed in the List of Oversized Waste. *Refer to the table on the right

Prior appointment is required.

The waste item can be put into a 45-L plastic bag. *Note that the weight of the bag should be less than 10 kg (for the bag to not be torn).

Miscellaneous trash

The total length of the width, depth, and height of the item is less than 2 m.

Miscellaneous trash
300 yen/item or bunch

The total length of the width, depth, and height of the item is 2 m or more and less than 3 m. (However, the length of each side should be less than 2 m.)

Prior appointment is required.

The total length of the width, depth, and height of the item is 3 m or more and less than 6 m. (However, the length of each side should be less than 2 m.)

Prior appointment is required for the collection of oversized waste.

Make an appointment at least two days (except for Saturdays and Sundays) before regular bulky waste collection days (twice a month).

Collection of batteries/fluorescent lights is free of charge.

(The drop-off boxes are located next to the drop-off box for small appliances.)



Used batteries

*Only disposable manganese and alkaline batteries are accepted.
*Do not put rechargeable batteries, button cells, and lithium-ion batteries in the drop-off boxes because these batteries may ignite.
*Commercial waste batteries are not accepted.



Fluorescent lights

*Only fluorescent lights using mercury (straight, circular, and compact types) generated by ordinary households are accepted.
*Fluorescent lights used by offices are not accepted.
*Incandescent light bulbs, Halogen lamps and LED lamps are classified as miscellaneous trash.

● If you don't use drop-off boxes, dispose of them on collection days for miscellaneous trash.

	Spring mattresses	1,800 yen
	Beds (excluding mattresses and electric adjustable beds)	Beds equal to or larger than double beds: 1,200 yen Beds other than those above: 600 yen
Hobby supplies	Exercise bikes, treadmills	Self-propelled machines: 600 yen Electric-powered machines: 1,200 yen
	Digital pianos, digital organs	1,200 yen
	Electric massagers (only massage chairs)	1,200 yen
	Bicycles	Smaller than an 18-inch bike: 300 yen 18-inch bike or larger: 600 yen

	Kitchen sinks (only sinks with width of up to 1 m)	600 yen
	Tatami mats	Half tatami mats: 300 yen One tatami mat: 600 yen
	Clothes drying poles, other poles (a set of up to three poles with length of 1 m or more and less than 2 m)	300 yen
	Reed screens (only reed screens with diameter of less than 30 cm when the screen is rolled up)	300 yen
	Common specifications	Items that are not in the list and meet the conditions to the right (only items with side of less than 2 m): 600 yen Items with width, depth, and height of 2 m or more and less than 3 m in total: 900 yen Items with width, depth, and height of 3 m or more and less than 6 m in total: 900 yen

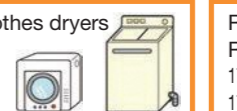
TVs (CRT, LCD and plasma)
Recycling fees
15 inches or smaller: Starting at 1,320 yen
16 inches or bigger: Starting at 2,420 yen



Air conditioners
Recycling fees
Starting at 990 yen



Washing machines/clothes dryers
Recycling fees
Starting at 2,530 yen



Refrigerators/freezers
Recycling fees
170 L or smaller: Starting at 3,740 yen
171 L or bigger: Starting at 4,730 yen

*Fees indicated above are for reference only. Recycling fees vary depending on the manufacturer.

How to dispose of them

Will you purchase a new appliance covered by the Home Appliances Recycling Law? Yes → Request the sales agent of the retailer where you will purchase the new appliance to collect your old appliance.

No

Are you able to request the sales agent where you purchased the appliance to be discarded to pick up the waste? Yes → Request the sales agent of the retailer where you purchased the old appliance to collect it.

Are you able to transport the waste appliance? Yes → After checking the manufacturer of the appliance, transfer the recycling fee from a post office (a transfer fee is separately required) and bring the waste to a designated drop-off location.

When requesting the city to transport the waste

- Schedule an appointment by calling the Telephone Appointment Center (☎ 06-6997-7766).
- Transfer the recycling fee from a post office in advance. (A transfer fee is separately required.)
- On the appointment date, the waste collector will pick up the waste appliance in the presence of the applicant. (The waste will be collected in front of your house or at the garbage collection site in the case of an apartment house.)
- Pay a transport fee of 3,500 yen per appliance. *When the waste collector picks up the waste appliance, the collector issues a statement of payment. Pay the fee at a financial institution later.

Precautions! Air conditioners, TVs, refrigerators/freezers, and washing machines/clothes dryers cannot be treated as oversized waste because these items are covered by the Home Appliances Recycling Law.

How to dispose of motorbikes
